Ondokuz Mayıs University Faculty of Fine Arts has an excellent academic staff in terms of quality and efficiency. Our country's first and only Fine Arts Themed Campus has independent workshops, galleries and exhibition halls for artistic productions and sharing. Our campus, which has the first hot and cold glass workshop in the Black Sea and its surrounding regions, has a ceramic workshop, industrial design workshop, visual communication design workshops, painting workshops and computer laboratories. The campus, considered the city's central point, is located in the middle of "old" and "new" Samsun. With its easy transportation facilities and accessibility, the Faculty of Fine Arts is an educational institution that brings the region's people together through art.

Established in 2012, our Faculty has three professors, four associate professors, seven doctoral faculty members, one doctoral research assistant, four lecturers and ten research assistants, and currently, nearly 600 students are studying.

In What Ways Do We Support the Professional, Cultural, and Social Atmosphere?

There are two types of association structures classified into professional and social categories within the body of our University. Professional associations are specific to faculties, while social associations are of a general nature.
