Statue of Honor, aka Atatürk Monument, is a monument situated at Atatürk Park in İlkadım district of Samsun, Turkey dedicated to the landing of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk in Samsun initiating what is later termed the Turkish War of Independence. The monument became the landmark of Samsun.

The equestrian statue of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk was commissioned in 1927 by the province governor of Samsun, Kâzım Pasha (İnanç) to the Austrian sculptor Heinrich Krippel.

The construction of the bronze statue took place in Vienna from 1928 to 1931.



Samsun – Bird Sanctuary

Kızılırmak Delta has 40% of 1.100 bird species in West Palearctic Region. While the existence of 483 bird species is recorded in Turkey; three quarters of them, 352 bird species are also observed in Kızılırmak Delta. This number is so far the highest value determined in South *Black Sea* Basin in this specific area. Famous for hosting rare species in the world and the number of birds with passerines passing over the delta, reaching a few millions; Kızılırmak Delta is also known as “Bird Sanctuary”.

Kızılırmak Delta is the biggest and most important wetland ecosystem of South Black Sea Basin, for representing habitat species specific to Black Sea in the best possible way and for having flora and fauna features that can sustain ecologic and genetic species. Kızılırmak Delta that has been included since 1998 in Ramsar Convention List that has the aim of conservation and sustainable utilization of wetlands meets its 8 criteria out of 9.

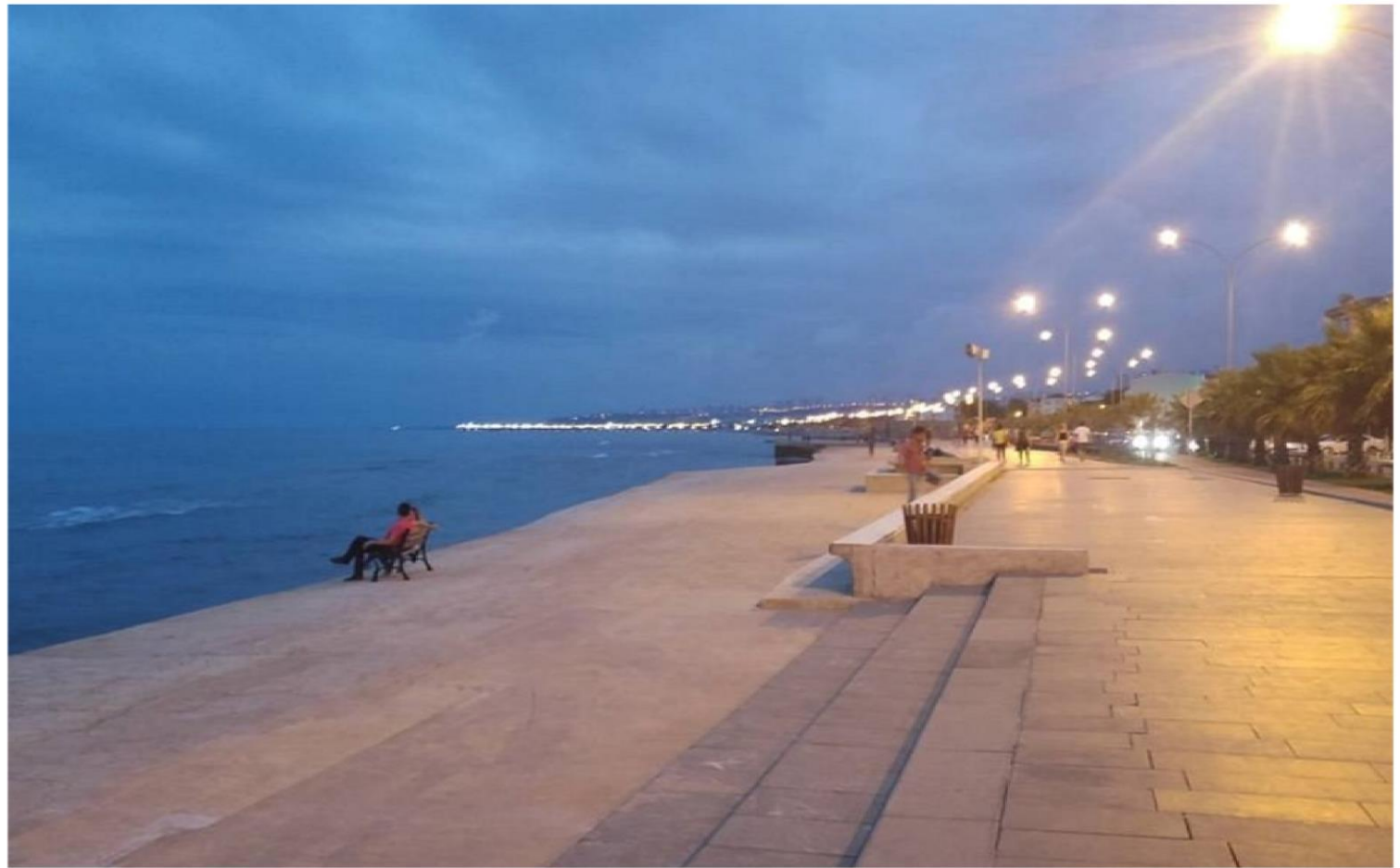

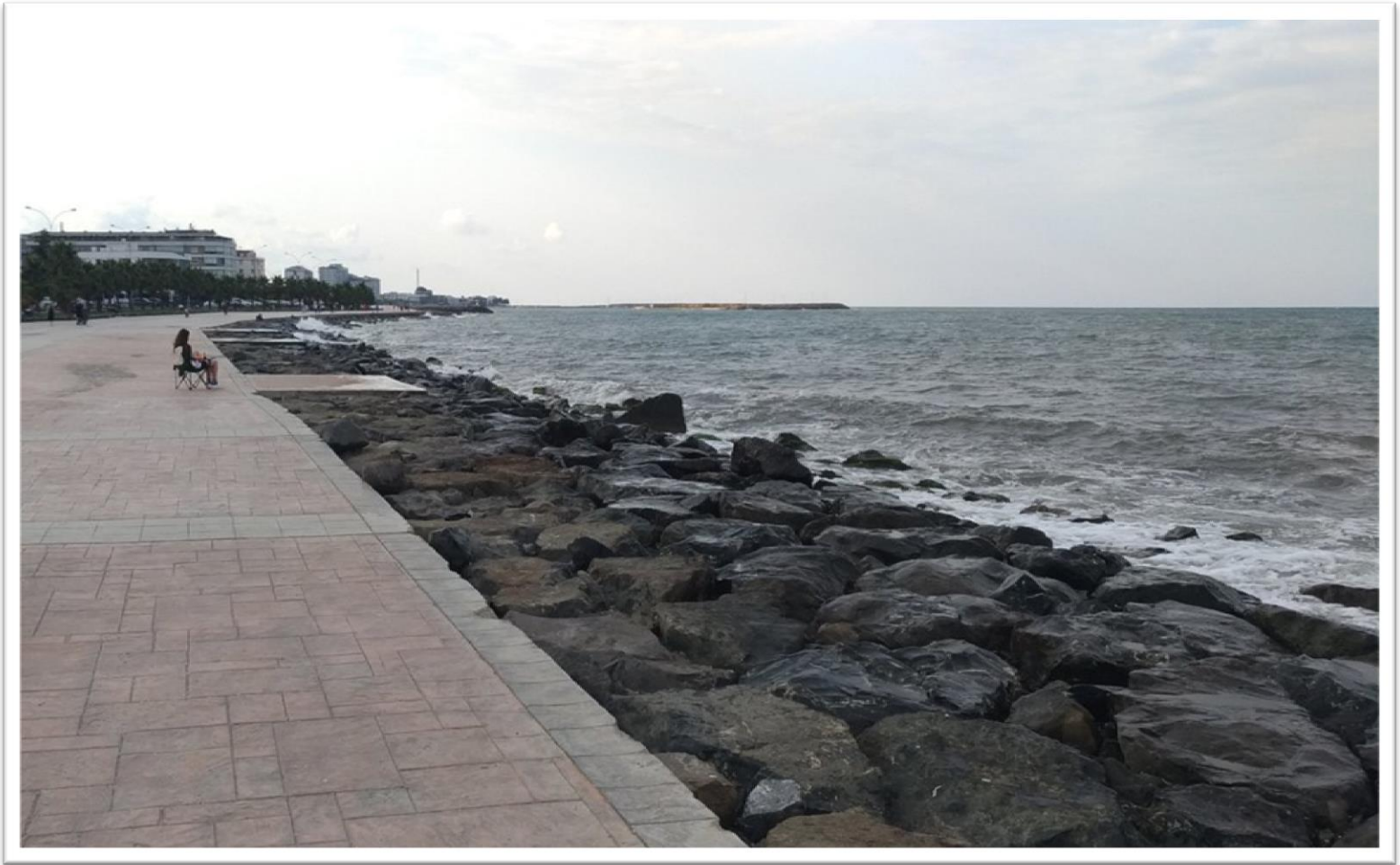

Samsun – City Museum



Samsun City Museum is a museum located in the İlkadım district of Samsun. The museum opened to visitors on February 12, 2013, and displays information and materials related to Samsun's social, historical, cultural, geographical, and economic structure. The museum attracted 20 thousand visitors in the first seventy days. It was also deemed worthy of the Jury's Special Award of the Historical Cities Association. Ondokuz Mayıs University helped establish the museum by providing documents and information. The museum reached the finals of the XX. Luigi Micheletti Awards held in 2015, making it one of Europe's six most prestigious museums.

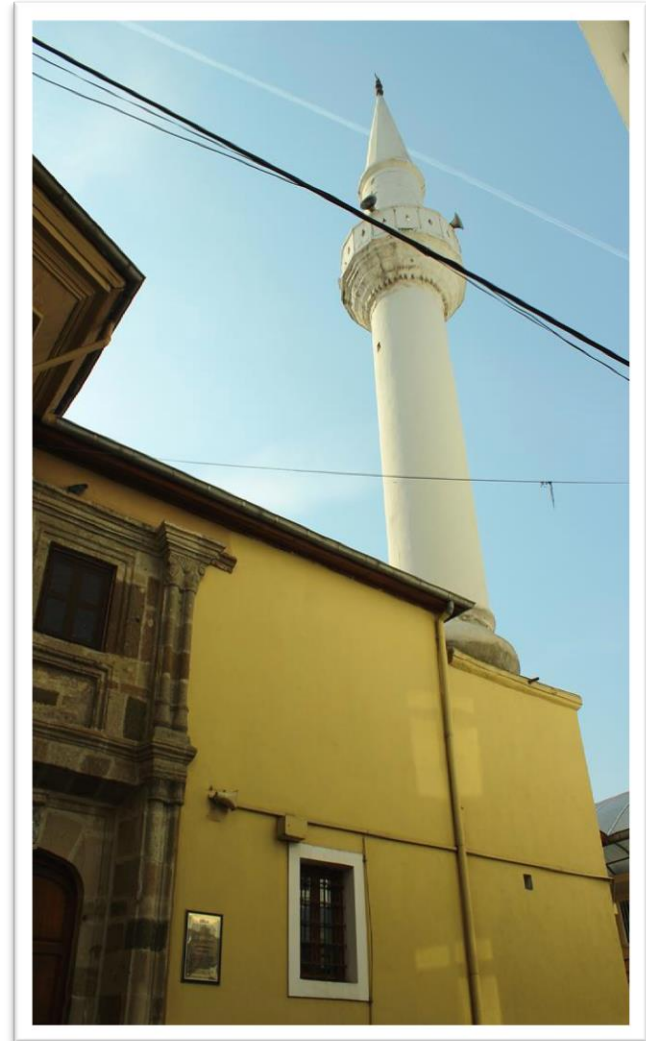
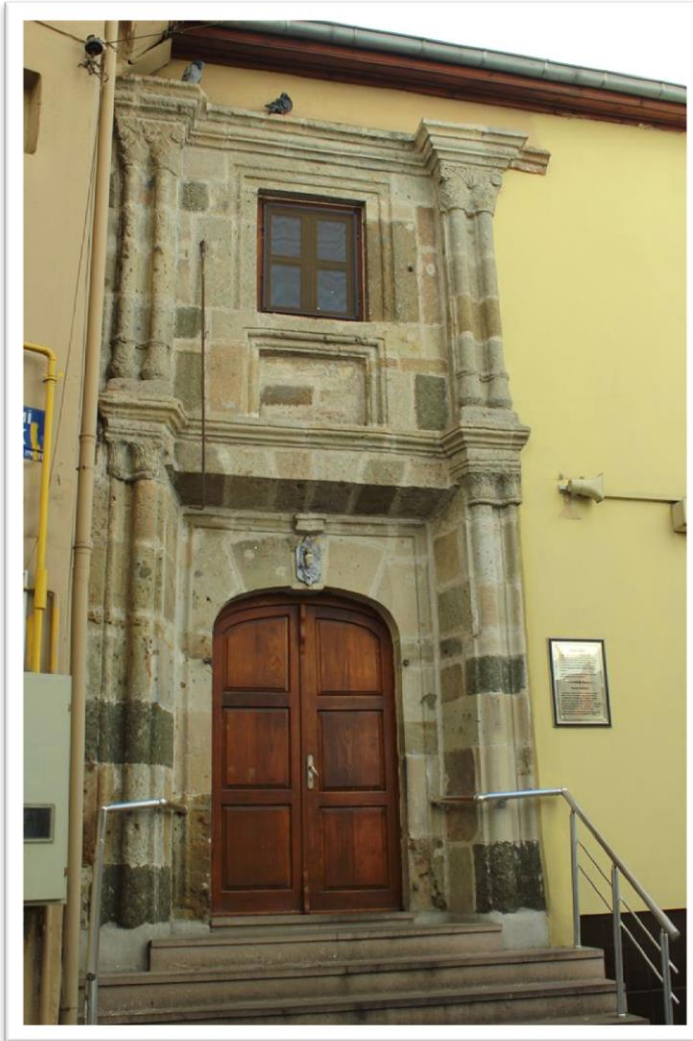

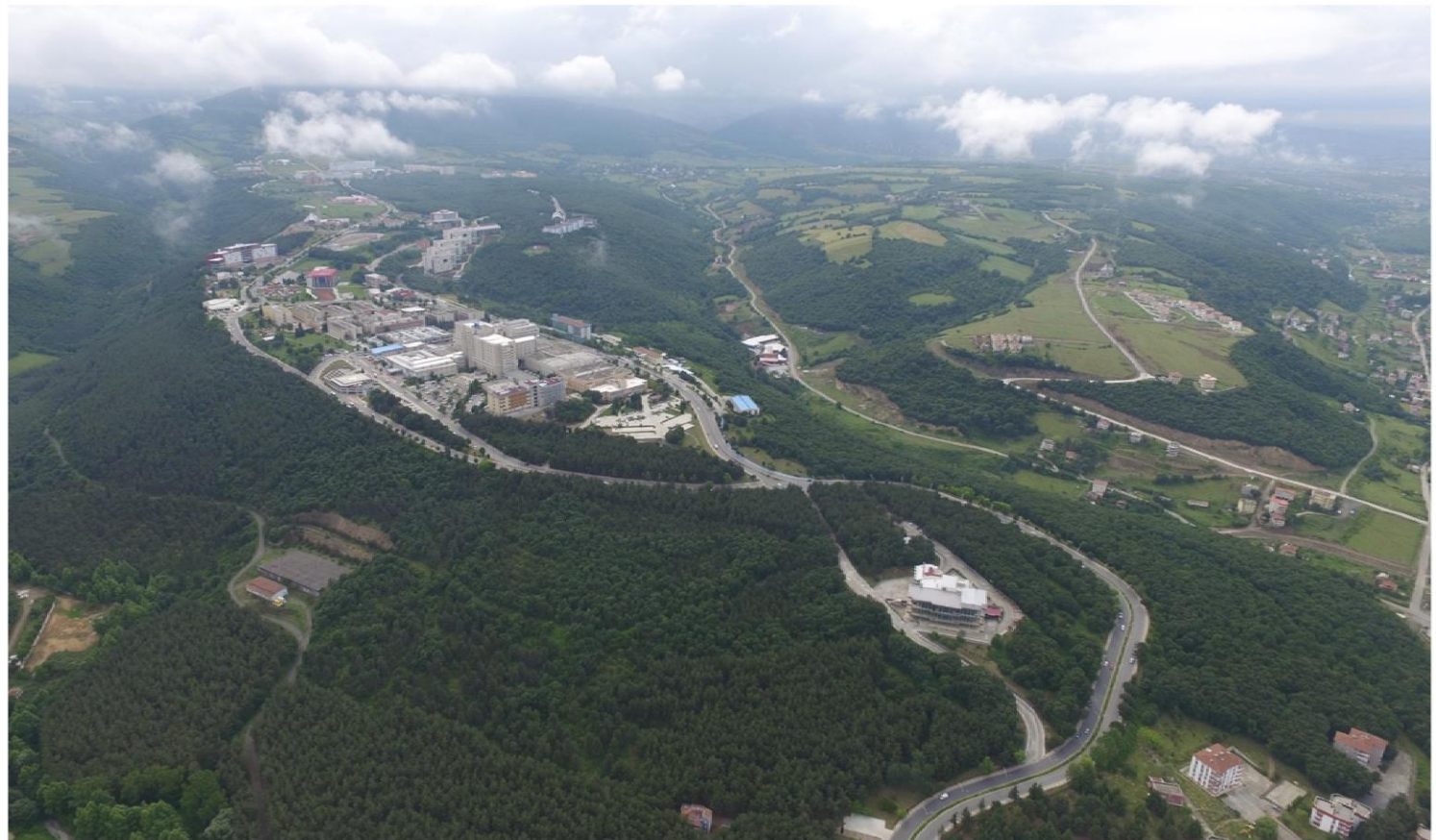

Erasmus+

For nearly 30 years, the EU has funded the Erasmus programme, which has enabled over three million European students to spend part of their studies at another higher education institution or with an organization in Europe.

OMU currently has 283 Erasmus+ agreements.

Ondokuz Mayıs University - Accommodation

International students have a variety of options to meet their accommodation needs throughout their educational life in Turkey. Students can stay in university dormitories located within the campuses, in state dormitories managed by the KYK (Higher Education Credit and Hostels Institution) located at various points in the city, in private dormitories, or in the apartments they rent in the city.

Almost all of the state dormitories and university dormitories in Turkey are separate for male and female students. Although the number of students staying in the rooms is variable, prices may increase or decrease usually depending on the number of people staying in the room.

In the room and common areas, every furniture that a student may need is available for students. Dormitories have wired / wireless Internet access available to all students. Some dormitories have their own cafeteria and usually serve breakfast and dinner here. Communal areas such as TV room, study room and kitchen are also available for students.

Monthly fees for dormitories operated by KYK range from 275 TL to 450 TL. Fees of the university dormitories vary according to physical characteristics of the room being accommodated.

Private Dormitories

It is possible to find private dormitories around most university campuses. The facilities offered by the private dormitories are mostly higher than the state dormitories (for example, newer and varied furniture), but their fees are higher.

Renting a House

Another accommodation option for international students is to rent a house. Especially in neighborhoods close to universities, many students rent a house with a few friends. You will have a lot of rental home options in Turkey which is rapidly developing in terms of housing quality and number. Of course, prices vary from city to city and according to the location and characteristics of the house. However, regardless of your budget, you can be sure that you will find a suitable home in the city you go to.

The houses in Turkey are usually in the form of an apartment. These apartments have a large living room as well as 2 to 4 additional bedrooms. Most of the houses have a balcony. Kitchen is located as a separate part of the house. Heating of the houses is provided by a central system or a combi boiler. The average rental rates of a 90 square meter house can cost between 1500 TL - 3.500 TL.

Remember! After you have signed a lease agreement with your landlord, various jobs such as buying household goods and subscriptions are waiting for you.

Joint Master's Programmes - Collaboration between CMU and OMU

Community of Mediterranean Universities (CMU) and OMU has signed a collaboration agreement on 13.06.2015 in order to organize and implement the following joint master's programmes

Collaboration between CMU and OMU

Euromediterranean Cultures and Tourism “Prof. Cosimo Notarstefano” (E.M.C.T.)

Our joint masters programme Euromediterranean Cultures and Tourism “Prof. Cosimo Notarstefano” (5th Edition) started on March, 2017 in Bari, Italy with a total of 8 students, and finalized on August, 2018 in Samsun, Turkey. Of these 8 students, 1 was Italian, 1 was Russian, and 6 were Turkish. These students completed an intensive 7 weeks course programme (6 days a week, 8 hours per day, totalling 300 hours), a training period at various international institutions, and also completed a 400 hours online education programme through a portal where all the related materials were uploaded.

The 6th edition of the programme is currently at its applications and registrations period.



OMU-YÖS: University Entrance Examination for International Students / General Information

- University Entrance Examination for International Students (OMÜ-YÖS) can be taken by international students wishing to study in Türkiye at associate and bachelor levels. OMÜ-YÖS results are accepted by most state and private universities in Türkiye.
- OMÜ-YÖS 2023 results are valid for **two years**.
- OMÜ-YÖS 2023 applications will be made completely online, and candidates will be able to take the exam in Turkish, English, French, Russian, Arabic, or Persian.
- Currently **19 Turkish universities** are using OMU-YOS results as their main selection criteria.



OMU-YÖS: University Entrance Examination for International Students / General Information

- In the OMÜ-YÖS 2023 Exam, a face to face test will be applied available either in Turkish, English, French, Russian, Arabic or Persian. This test consists of Basic Learning Skills and Mathematics questions. The Basic Learning Skills Test is designed to measure the abstract thinking abilities, basic knowledge and skills of the candidates. The Mathematics Test is designed to measure the mathematical thinking and problem solving competency and abilities of the candidates and consists of mathematical questions on algebra, analysis and geometry.
- A total of 80 questions will be asked in the exam. 40 of these will consist of questions on Basic Learning Skills and 40 on Mathematics. Candidates will be given a total of 120 minutes (2 hours).



OMU-YÖS: University Entrance Examination for International Students / Why should you take OMu-YÖS?

There are three separate application periods during the Ondokuz Mayıs University student selection process:

1. The first selection period is reserved only for the candidates who have a valid OMu-YÖS score. This means that the candidates who have taken the OMu-YÖS will have more department or programme alternatives to choose from. In this regard, if a candidate wishes to study in a programme which is in high demand, having an OMu-YÖS result becomes a necessity. We also would like to remind you that the OMu-YÖS score needed for a particular department increases with the overall demand for that particular department. This means that in order to get into departments such as Medicine or Dentistry which are always in high demand, a candidate should get a high exam score.



OMU-YÖS: University Entrance Examination for International Students / Why should you take Omu-YÖS?

There are three separate application periods during the Ondokuz Mayıs University student selection process:

2. At the second selection period the remaining quotas from the first selection period are opened for the candidates who have a valid YÖS score obtained from other universities in Turkey. You can find the list of the accepted YÖS exams at:

Candidates who have valid Omu-YÖS scores can also apply at this stage.

3. At the third and final selection period, the remaining quotas from the first and second selection periods are re-opened for candidates who wish to apply with their high school diplomas. The GPAs of these students are used for evaluation.

Candidates who have valid Omu-YÖS or accepted YÖS scores can also apply at this stage.



Scholarships – Türkiye Scholarships

With the implementation of Türkiye Scholarships in 2012, which received around 40.000 applications in its first year, a rapid increase was witnessed in the application numbers throughout the years, to reach about 150 thousand applications in 2019.

Türkiye Scholarships is a scholarship program which not only provides financial support but also ensures university placement for students in their intended program of application. With this feature, it differs from other scholarship programs in the world. Apart from university education, it is aimed to provide students with the benefits of social, cultural and academic extra- curricular programs and activities while they are in Turkey.

Today Türkiye Scholarships is a well-known scholarship program in most countries of different continents.

Offering support also to academicians, researchers and civil servants in other countries, Türkiye Scholarships program offers various modules for research and Turkish language education.

Close communication with international students is sustained not only during their education but also after their graduation. Students who have completed their higher education in Turkey become voluntarily country ambassadors who build bridges of friendship between Turkey and their countries. Therefore, the Turkey Alumni network has been established in order to protect our ties with our alumni around the world.

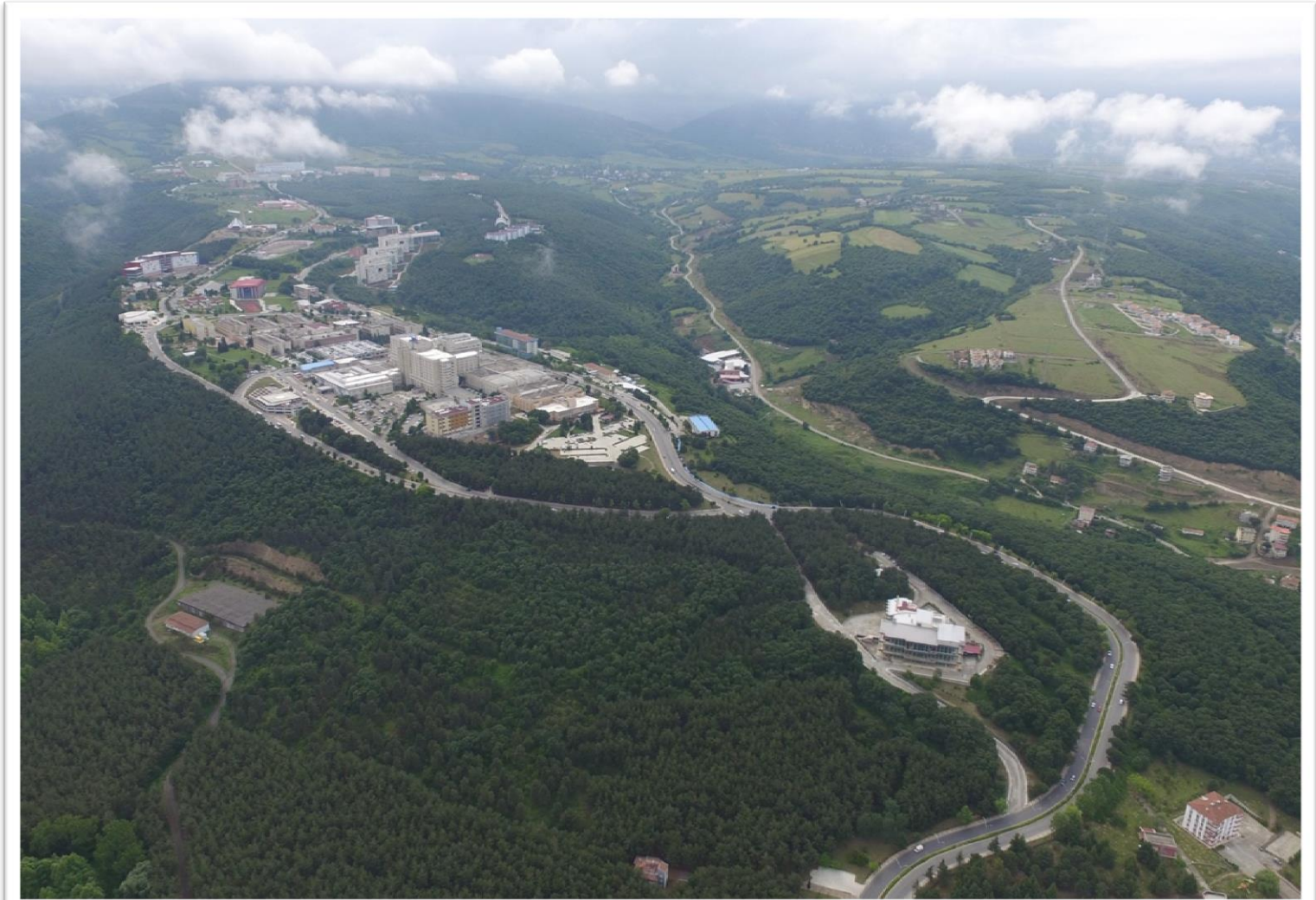
