Who Are We?

The institutes started their activities as the Institute of Science in 1982, the Institute of Health Sciences in 1983, the Institute of Social Sciences in 1985, and the Institute of Fine Arts in 1992, and were then gathered under the body of the Institute of Graduate Studies in 2020.

The Institute of Graduate Studies is a research institution established to produce knowledge in many departments and to train qualified and well-equipped scientists. The Institute has 92 doctorate, 124 master's with thesis, 16 master's without thesis, and 17 distance education programs.

In addition to more than 200 students, the Institute also offers postgraduate education to 43 students within the Erasmus exchange program.

What About Our Qualifications and Academic Vision?

The Institute of graduate studies is important in terms of a sufficient number of faculty members, experienced and well-equipped academics and employees, technological opportunities, and physical space competencies. With this infrastructure, the Institute aims to train well-equipped students with the vision of being a center that produces and distributes knowledge.
